Clerk's report to Councillors for 09/09/19 (matters arising from the minutes)

Matters arising from 1st July minutes:

19070/04 Now the dog waste bins are in situ, the signs have been requested. Note to Enforcement officer has been actioned.

190701/05 The Community Scheme were also asked to cut back some hedges that were overgrowing onto pavements.

190701/08 Planning responses have been submitted

9 and 10 are agenda items.

Matters arising from 5th August minutes:

All planning responses were submitted on time.

190805/5 Gloucestershire Minerals Local Plan: Council's response has been submitted for this. Temple Guiting PC considered this at their meeting on the 4/09/19 and will be making a detailed response. I'd recommend that this council supports their comments, in addition to the response already submitted.
